In this case, the writer simply tells the reader what he or she wants the reader to know. Direct characterization is in contrast to indirect characterization, the latter being a process by which the author reveals information through the thoughts, words, or actions of the character. Both have a place in literature, but there are times when one method is generally preferred over the other.

DIRECT AND INDIRECT CHARACTERIZATION EXERCISES. Direct Characterization (TELLING): The author (or another character) directly tells the traits of a character. Example: Joe. is . mean and angry. Indirect Characterization (SHOWING): The author shows the reader the traits of a character through that character's thoughts, words, and actions.
