This guide covers all premises where the main use is to provide sleeping accommodation, including hotels, guest houses, bed and breakfast accommodation, hostels, residential training centres, holiday accommodation and the common areas of flats, maisonettes, houses in multiple occupation, and sheltered housing (other than those providing care). It does not cover domestic premises occupied as a single private dwelling, hospitals, residential care and nursing homes, prisons and other establishments where people are in lawful custody. This guide does not set prescriptive standards, but provides recommendations and guidance for use when assessing the adequacy of fire precautions in small and medium places of assembly.
